Code of Ethics

- 1. To be respectful, considerate, patient, tolerant and inclusive towards other members, prospective members and members of the public irrespective of age, gender, orientation, nationality, race or religion.
- 2. To not bring the club into disrepute through actions, public statements or on social media.
- 3. To take responsibility for making the club a friendly and enjoyable experience.
- 4. To report any inappropriate behaviour swiftly to a member of the Club Committee.
- 5. To pay the appropriate club subscriptions in a timely manner.
- 6. In the event that you are selected to play representative matches for the club, to ensure you are a member of the Irish Chess Union so that the club does not suffer any points deductions.
- 7. To observe the rules of chess.
- 8. To protect and keep secure the club equipment.
- 9. To help set up and/or put away the equipment after a game.
- 10. When club members are engaged in competition whether with other DunLaoghaire Chess Club members, or with players from outside the club, they should:
 - Act with respect towards opponents, opposing teams and club premises and equipment.
 - Avoid conversations with anyone else and respect the need for quiet while games are in progress.
 - Not open snack food wrappings, drink cans etc. at the board.
 - Avoid distracting an opponent either verbally or through actions.

Players who have finished their games, other observers, spectators and other club members present in the playing area should:

- Adhere to the spirit of the above code for players.
- Ensure that mobile phones are turned off in the play area.
- Not under any circumstances give advice while the game is in progress.

- Not intervene or interfere in games in progress in any other way.
- Refrain from conversations while games are in progress.
